

Dog Owners Beware

Are you seeing these symptoms on your lawn? Take a look at the family pet as it is the result of ***Pet Urine.***



1. Who are the main culprits?

Female dog urine is usually worse than that of the male dog for a range of reasons. The ammonia in urine in high concentrations is an effective grass killer.

2. What do I do?

A dehydrated dog or morning urine is more toxic, also the frequency with which your dog urinates during the day will affect the concentration. Keeping your dog hydrated will help.

Another possible solution is to ask at your local pet store for charcoal water rocks or a similar product that you add to the dog's drinking water, it can neutralise the dog's urine and may assist.

Otherwise, a full watering can kept close by to 'flush after' is an effective but more labour intensive solution. 😊
